CORPS MEMORIAL AND VETERANS WEEKEND 14 - 16 SEPTEMBER 2018

1. **Introduction.** The Corps Memorial and Veterans Weekend will take place on 14 - 16 September 2018 in Chatham. There will be events across the weekend to promote *esprit de Corps* between veterans and serving members. I would like to emphasise that the primary purpose of the weekend is the Memorial Parade and the subsequent service in Rochester Cathedral in remembrance of those Sappers who have died on operations or otherwise.

2. **Planned Events.** The weekend will start with a meet and greet on the Friday night in the Warrant Officers and Sergeants' mess, this event will be led by the REA Medway branch. The Saturday will start with a Corps SM update, various static displays on the Regt'l square and both the Museum and Sapper shop will be open throughout the day. Traditional events such as the Dove Cup Darts Competition and the National Standard Bearers Competition will also run throughout the day, the day will finish off with a formal sit-down meal in the Warrant Officers and Sergeants' mess. The Parade on Sunday will be shorter than previous years to alleviate the need for veterans to stand for long periods of time; hopefully this will encourage more veterans to take part. The main parade at Brompton Barracks on Sunday 16 September 2018 will be centred at the Obelisk and not the Regt'l square as previous years. A detailed programme of events will be contained within the welcome pack issued on arrival.

3. **Notice of Attendance.** Branch Secretaries are requested to return completed notice of attendance proforma (Enclosure 2) and Branch attendance nominal rolls (Enclosure 3) with accurate figures for attendance by **27 July 2018** to the following address:

4. **Accommodation.** Due to extensive reconstruction within Brompton Barracks, members that have not attended for a few years will see considerable change within Chatham Station. The main noticeable change is the relocation of the Warrant Officers and Sergeants' mess. It should be noted that there will be no accommodation available in the Warrant Officers and Sergeants' mess. Accommodation for unaccompanied veterans will be available at nil cost within Collingwood Triangle (not Kitchener Barracks) on Friday and Saturday evening. Unfortunately, accompanied personnel cannot be accommodated. Accommodation request proforma (Enclosure 4) should be completed and returned by **27 July 2018.** Any bids received after this date will be considered but not guaranteed. To ensure disabled personnel are allocated ground floor accommodation, please ensure they are identified on the return; this includes individuals who may have difficulty negotiating stairs.

5. **Local Hotels.** A list of hotels in the Medway area is enclosed (Enclosure 5). The list is not exhaustive and does not constitute official endorsement. Prices can be obtained by contacting the proprietor directly.

6. **Meals.** Meals can be purchased in the Central Mess Brompton Barracks. Branch Secretaries are requested to complete the enclosed meals required proforma (Enclosure 6) and return it to Sgt Basnet on the address in Para 3 by **27 July 2018**, annotating the total number from your branch who intend to take each meal (in order to allow sufficient food to be ordered). Food will be supplied in the Warrant Officers and Sergeants' mess on the Friday and Saturday evening of the weekend, in addition Sunday lunch will be available in the Central Mess Brompton Barracks. If individuals wish to eat prior to the events on the Friday or Saturday evening, they are welcome to eat beforehand in the Central Mess.

7. **Reception.** On arrival each member must book in at the Student Reception Centre in Brompton Barracks. The reception will be open from 1400-2300 on Friday 14 September 2018 and 0800-1800 on Saturday 15 September 2018. A detailed programme of events will be issued on arrival.

8. **Security.** The security and integrity of Chatham station is of the utmost importance, and cars entering camp are liable to be searched. Occupants are requested to be patient and fully cooperative with the security measures in place over the weekend. REA members are to carry their REA membership cards at all times whilst within the confines of camp.

9. **Vehicle Parking.** With the closure of Kitchener Barracks there is only limited vehicle parking within Brompton Barracks, REA members are strongly encouraged to share cars where possible.

10. **Returns.** Branch Secretaries are requested to ensure that all returns are sent to Sgt Basnet by **27 July 2018**.

11. **Payment.** CMVW 2018 will be the first time all personnel attending will be asked to contribute £25 per person towards the weekend, the contribution will be towards the whole weekend and not, for example, the Friday night meet and greet. This will bring CMVW in line with the other REA weekends in Minley, Chilwell and Gibraltar who also ask for contributions. A bank transfer will be requested from each branch by the return cut-off date 27 July 18. Transfers are to be referenced with your branch location for example 'CMW REA Medway' for the Medway branch 'CMW REA Plymouth' for the Plymouth branch and so on. Branch chairmen are requested to collect funds per branch and transfer to 1 RSME Regiment as a one-off payment. Transfers are to be made to:
