

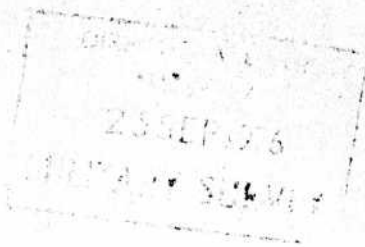

EXERCISE CARTO NORGE 1976

For this years field work it was impossible to accommodate the Survey unit within a military establishment. Since this was a new situation and since it had to be in an area where training of allied troops normally does not take place, Forsvarets karttjeneste has been especially interested in 13 Field Survey Squadrons cooperation with the civilians and the military unit responsible for the liaison to the squadron.

It is a pleasure to inform you that FKT have received a very favourable report from ltcol Amundsen, Commanding Officer of the host unit, - The Home Guard School at Torpo (HVSKT). In his report the Commanding Officer states:

"After the 13 FIELD SURVEY SQUADRON RE now terminated its service in Hallingdal, I find it correct as Commanding Officer of HVSKT, to express that the school as host unit is left with the best impression of the unit.

It has been a pleasure to cooperate with Capt G.C. PARKES during the units stay here from 8 July - 3 September 1976. He has kept very good order in his camp at Lya, as well as in all his outstanding matters with the school. All the material borrowed from the school and the Quartermaster General has been returned in satisfactory condition.

During the stay not a single complaint of any kind has appeared about the unit or its personel.

Externally - towards the small civilian community - I have as Commanding Officer of the school been given the impression that the unit has been a popular element".
