Foreword

In May 1956 HMS Leverton was assigned to patrol duties off the south coast of Cyprus.

At the instigation of the Flag Officer Middle East, Rear Admiral A. C. C. Meirs, &c., DSO., RN., an affiliation arose between HMS Leverton and 42 Survey Engineer Regiment, Royal Engineers, stationed at Zyyi. This association has been a great success since its inception, and has created a strong bond of friendship which is shared by all ranks. To date, some seventy officers and men of the Regiment have sailed in HMS Leverton on patrol, and in return the Regiment has welcomed Leverton's crew whenever they have had the opportunity of coming ashore at Zyyi.

It is to commemorate the affiliation, and on the occasion of HMS Leverton leaving Cyprus waters, that the Captain and Ship's Company present today to the Commanding Officer and All Ranks 42 Survey Engineer Regiment, the ship's Battle Ensign flown during the action at Port Said in 1956. There is also to be an exchange of plaques between the Ship and the Regiment.

The presentation of the Battle Ensign will take place at a parade of the two units today, May 20th 1957 at 11 a.m.

The Salute will be taken by Rear Admiral A. C. C. Meirs, VC., DSO., RN.
